

**CAMP TRINITY
HURRICANE EVACUATION POLICY**

In case of hurricane watch and warnings for Camp Trinity on Bogue Island, the following evacuation procedures will be put into effect if Camp Trinity has to evacuate the island:

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| Condition 4 | Transportation availability will be confirmed. |
| Condition 3 | Watch: 36-48 hours to forecasted landfall. Liaison with the Rector of St. Mary's Episcopal Church, Kinston, will be established. |
| Condition 2 | Warning: 24-35 hours to forecasted landfall. Prepare camp, camp staff, and campers for evacuation. |
| Condition 1 | Evacuation: 18-24 hours to forecasted landfall. Board buses and travel best route to St. Mary's Episcopal Church, Kinston, NC. |

Because county officials may close bridges as wind speeds become excessive, evacuation may begin during Condition 2. An assessment will be made, utilizing strike probability information, time of day, expected Condition 1 call, and other pertinent data to establish a conservative evacuation time.

Parents will only be notified by Trinity Center staff in the event of an evacuation. Parents are welcome to call or email and check on campers; they are also invited to visit the Camp Trinity Facebook page or Instagram page for updates.

If campers are evacuated and return to camp is not feasible because of damage or end of session, campers must be picked up in Kinston.
